Lübeck – Stralsund

ON THE BIKE FROM LÜBECK TO STRALSUND

This wonderful cycle tour starts in the northern German city of Lübeck. Before you cycle along the Baltic Sea, you still have enough time to explore Lübeck and its sights. Take a leisurely stroll through the old town, which offers a lot of culture. The impressive brick buildings will immediately catch your eye.

You should definitely visit the Marienkirche, the Holstentor and the Lübeck town hall. Would you like a break? Numerous shops and nice restaurants invite you to take a stroll and enjoy yourself. After the city trip, it's time to hop on the saddle! Then you pedal towards Stralsund.

Details of the Baltic Sea Cycle Path II

The Baltic Sea cycle tour runs through the incomparable coastal landscape of Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania. You cycle comfortably along fine sandy beaches and old seaside resorts. Enchanting fishing villages line the beautiful cycle route along the Baltic Sea.

What awaits you? A unique landscape, imposing cliffs and impressive pine forests. The cultural aspect plays a special role on this trip: important Hanseatic cities and numerous tourist attractions will delight you on the way from Lübeck to Stralsund.

The highlights of the Baltic Sea Cycle Path II

- **Wismar:** The Hanseatic city of Wismar is one of the most beautiful cities in Mecklenburg-Western Pomerania. Stroll through the city and enjoy the charm and flair of the area. Culture tip: the market square with its magnificent buildings is definitely worth a visit!
- **Incomparable landscape:** On the cycle path along the Baltic Sea, one thing is very special: nature! Between charming fishing villages and rich Hanseatic cities, you can explore the landscape of the Baltic Sea. Lighthouses, coasts, old manor houses and churches line the way. Like in a picture book!

Interesting facts about the route from Lübeck to Stralsund

Do you prefer leisurely tours? Then this cycle tour from Lübeck to Stralsund is perfect for you! The cycle route leads through flat and partly slightly hilly terrain. In total, you will cycle around 335 kilometres along the Baltic Sea over eight days. If you need a break in between, you can also shorten individual cycling stages by train. What are you waiting for? Itinerary

DAY
1

Arrival in Lübeck

You start the tour in the magnificent old Hanseatic city of Lübeck which was named a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1987.

DAY
2

Lübeck - Boltenhagen (Cat.A) Lübeck - Hohen Schönberg/Boltenhagen (Cat.B)

approx. 40/45 km + ferry ride

First through the spa town of Travemünde and then along the Baltic Sea coast. Cycling through the Brooker Wald nature reserve to Boltenhagen. From the cliffs you have a great view over the entire bay.

DAY
3

Hohen Schönberg/Boltenhagen – Wismar

approx. 30-45 km

Mostly following the banks you cycle to the Hanseatic city of Wismar. Poel island with its long sandy beaches and the historic city walls dating back to the Thirty Years' War is worth a visit. .

DAY
4

Wismar – Kühlungsborn/Warnemünde (Kat A) Wismar - Bad Doberan (Kat B)

approx. 45/65 km + boat and train ride

On your way to Kühlungsborn you will see cliff lines as well as wonderful beaches. Stroll through the English park Kamp in Bad Doberan or board the train „Molli“ that takes you to the beach.

DAY
5

Kühlungsborn/Warnemünde/Bad Doberan – Ribitz- Damgarten/Ahrenshoop

approx. 30-60 km + ferry ride

In Warnemünde you should sit at the widest sandy beach of the Baltic Sea coast. Wustrow is located on a peninsula called „Fischland-Dars“ which used to be the border between Mecklenburg and Pomerania.

DAY
6*Ribitz-Damgarten/Ahrenshoop – Zingst/Barht*

approx. 25/60 km

Explore the „Darser Urwald“ (Darss Jungle) and the wild romantic „Weststrand“ (west beach), one of the most beautiful beaches in the world. Via Zingst you get back to the mainland to the former Swedish town of Barth.

DAY
7*Zingst/Barth – Stralsund*

approx. 60/50 km

From far away you'll see the three towers of the Hanseatic city of Stralsund. Its former importance as a trading city can still be seen in the old town, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

DAY
8*Departure or extension*

Tour character

Mainly on level ground, sometimes slightly hilly, mostly on quiet country roads, cycle paths, field and forest trails, occasionally on sandy tracks, concreted paths and on cobblestone. The route is not always along the coast but takes frequent swings into the varied countryside further inland.
