Majorca Loop Tour

A DIFFERENT SIDE TO THE BALFARIC ISLAND

You can explore the island in a different way on the big tour around Mallorca, far away from the wild parties and crowded beaches. Dreamlike bays, unspoiled beaches and charming fishing villages without the tourist crowds: all this makes a holiday on two wheels across Spain's most popular holiday island a special experience.

Those who love the sound of the sea, coupled with a fresh breeze and wonderful southern warmth are on the right track on Mallorca's cycle paths! So much is clear: this cycle tour is a true all-rounder, because culture, exercise and enjoyment are all included. And happiness is guaranteed!

Details about the Mallorca tour

Your tour starts in Playa de Palma. Around 270 kilometres of cycling over eight days lie ahead of you. **But there's no need to worry,** there is plenty of time for breaks and recovery. Whether you prefer a dip in the sparkling Mediterranean Sea, a nap on the beach or a stroll through picturesque towns – unspoiled Mallorca is at your feet.

But that's not all! For what would a holiday on the Balearic Island be without indulging in some culinary delights? Your mouth will already be watering at the mere thought of the traditional Spanish kitchen. Paella, grilled vegetables and fine wines. Where? On the coast with a fantastic sunset and lovely little towns inland.

Highlights of the cycle tour in Mallorca

- **'Es Trenc'** On the first stage you already reach Mallorca's most beautiful white sandy beach. Fancy the sea? On the way to Colònia Sant Jordi, picturesque coves and sandy beaches with turquoise waters wait to be discovered.
- The Drach Caves The famous Drach Caves lie in the Mallorcan village of Porto Cristo. The special feature: deep inside the cave you'll find the largest underground lake in Europe. A guided tour through this natural wonder is definitely an experience!


• **Fornalutx** – You cycle through lemon and orange plantations to the 'most beautiful village in Spain'. Delicious paella and a wonderful glass of wine await you in the cosy terrace bars.

Useful information about the Mallorca tour

On the eight-day cycle tour you cover between 50 and 65 kilometres per day. The tour is considered easy to moderate. After the achievable climbs, beautiful downhill runs usually follow, where you can have a breather.

What are you waiting for? Hop onto the bike saddle and off you go to discover the tour through unspoiled Mallorca.

Arrival in Playa de Palma

Take a taxi from the airport to your first hotel.

Hotel (example): Hotel Java



Playa de Palma – Colònia Sant Jordi

approx. 55 km

Welcome reception and discussion of the tour. Your first stage will take you along the coast to Capocorp Vell, the Realm of the Cyclops (remnants of the native inhabitant dwellings). Typical wind mills line the way to the salt fields of Llevant with its pink and white shimmering salt lakes. In Sant Jordi, sandy beaches with crystal clear water are awaiting you.

Hotel (example): Hotel Sur Mallorca



Colònia Sant Jordi – Porto Cristo/surrounding

approx. 55-65 km

Today, you will cycle through Ses Salines to a botanical garden and visit the picturesque bay of Cala Santanyi. Later, you will continue your journey through small fishing villages to the famous natural bridge "Es Pontas". At Porto Cristo you will discover the Dragon Caves with their bizarre images and shapes.

Hotel (example): Hotel Felip



Porto Cristo/surrounding – C'an Picafort

approx. 60 km

On the fourth day, you will cycle through the sedate village of Son Carrio to Manacor, the city of the Majorcan beads and pottery. Afterwards, your journey will take you through Petra (typical Majorcan lunch snack will be prepared) and Santa Margalida and through one of the most charming landscapes of the island to C'an Picafort.

Hotel (example): Hotel Platja Daurada



Port de Pollenca/Alcúdia approx. 40 km

You do not need to pack your suitcase today. You will stay for another night in C'an Picafort. Today's tour will take you through a bird park (nature reserve) to the Bay of Pollensa (Roman port). Later, you will continue along the coast to Alcúdia (oldest city of the island) and back to C'an Picafort.

Hotel (example): Hotel Platja Daurada



C'an Picafort – Port de Sóller

approx. 50 km + bus transfer

Today you will cycle inland through Muro and Inca to the mountains cape of the Sierra de Tramuntana. A bus will take you to the Lluc monastery (possibility for sightseeing) and later to 1,200 m above sea level. Afterwards, you will continue your trip through Fornalutx (most beautiful village in Spain), and partly through orange and lemon plantations to Port de Sóller, one of the most charming fishing villages of the island. Usually, you will get the chance to enjoy an excellent paella meal in Fornalutx (inclusive).

Hotel (example): Hotel Marina



Port de Sóller – Playa de Palma

approx. 55 km

Breath-taking views of the sea are accompanying you on the last cycling day. You will cycle trough the picturesque towns of Deia and Valldemossa until you get to the West coast of the island leading you to the city of Palma. The capital city with its narrow alleys and squares is a must to explore before you are heading back to where you have started you tour.

The different stages are easy to moderate in difficulty: some climbs will be followed by pleasant descents; you cross the Tramuntana Mountains by bus. You will cycle on cycle paths, side roads and mainly on tarmacked agricultural roads, avoiding traffic as much as possible.
